Written declaration on attempts to secure the forfeiture of the St Gabriel monastery in south-eastern Turkey

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 116 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas a group of Turkish and Kurdish Muslims has brought legal proceedings with a view to securing a declaration of forfeiture of the St Gabriel monastery near Midyat in south-eastern Turkey,
- B. whereas such proceedings constitute a flagrant violation of freedom of religion, which is an essential component of the Copenhagen political criteria,
- 1. Condemns these legal proceedings and considers them to be in flagrant violation of the Copenhagen criteria;
- 2. Is concerned about the climate of growing intolerance towards religious minorities in Turkey, which goes hand in hand with the on-going Islamisation of the country;
- 3. Calls on the Commission at long last to make protecting religious minorities in Turkey a priority;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this declaration, together with the names of the signatories, to the Council, the Commission and the Turkish Government.
