Written declaration, pursuant to Rule 136 of the Rules of Procedure, on the prevention and treatment of head and neck cancers¹

- 1. Head and neck cancers are the sixth most common form of cancer worldwide.
- 2. Every year 150 000 people in Europe are diagnosed with head and neck cancers; 70 000 of them die.
- 3. In some 60 % of cases the disease is diagnosed at an advanced stage and about half of the people concerned die within five years.
- 4. Patients who are diagnosed and treated in the early stages of the disease have an 80-90 % chance of survival.
- 5. A multidisciplinary approach involving experts in various areas reduces the time taken to diagnose and treat head and neck cancers.
- 6. The Commission is therefore called upon to:
 - propose a series of measures designed to ensure that people in Europe are sufficiently well informed about the symptoms of head and neck cancers;
 - encourage the Member States to employ the multidisciplinary approach and draw up European guidelines;
 - organise courses to raise awareness about the need to adopt a healthy lifestyle.
- 7. This declaration, together with the names of the signatories, is forwarded to the Council and the Commission.

¹ In accordance with Rule 136(4) and (5) of Parliament's Rules of Procedure, when the declaration is signed by a majority of Parliament's component Members, it shall be published in the minutes with the names of its signatories and forwarded to the addressees, without however binding Parliament.
