Subject: Regulation of alcohol consumption on various forms of transport, particularly aircraft

Drunkenness among passengers on various forms of transport is a relatively frequent occurrence. Such is the case on aircraft, where alcohol is served to passengers free of charge, with no restrictions on quantity.

Bearing in mind the inconvenience these kinds of situations cause for both passengers and crew, and the inadvisability, from the point of view of health, of consuming alcoholic beverages while travelling, especially on long plane journeys, will the Council state whether it has given consideration to this issue with a view to regulating the consumption of alcoholic beverages on various forms of transport, and on aircraft in particular?

If so, what conclusions has it reached?
