Subject: Administrative cases brought by officials and other staff of the European Commission

In its White Paper on administrative reform, the Commission maintains that it wants to make its staff policy more effective by means of a clear definition of tasks and greater managerial responsibility for staff, who in certain circumstances would be awarded financial premiums.

In the light of this, can the Commission indicate for the past five years:

- the number and subject of actions brought in the Court of First Instance and the Court of Justice by officials and other staff, involving the application of the Staff Regulations, other than cases brought by the Ombudsman;
- how many of these actions were upheld, even in part, by the Court of First Instance and the Court of Justice and what were the main grounds for the decisions;
- what measures have been taken to remedy management failings established by the Court of First Instance?
