Subject: Countries which have set in place essential elements of the Integrated Administration and Control System for certain Community aid schemes (IACS)

In order to establish the precise situation in the Member States and the willingness of each one to fully comply with the provisions regarding controls on Community aid, will the Commission say:

- 1. To what extent has the IACS been set up in the EU Member States? Which countries have not yet completed implementation, and what are the prospects for implementation in future?
- 2. Which countries have submitted full statistical data relating to the IACS and on which countries have financial corrective measures been imposed owing to a failure to submit the above data?
- 3. What is the rate of implementation of on-the-spot checks and how reliable are they?
- 4. Does a single computer database exist for the programme, and, if so, is it available to the bodies involved in implementing it?
- 5. In which countries has codification on the basis of orthophoto maps been completed?
- 6. What progress has Greece made in implementing elements of the IACS, and what is the outlook for 2003?
