Subject: Fees at the European Schools

Some weeks ago, the European Commission wrote a letter to the Board of Governors of the European Schools proposing a drastic increase in the level of school fees for pupils at the European Schools. There is even talk of raising the annual fee to EUR 12 500 per pupil. Can further clarification be provided regarding the Commission's proposal and the reasons for this drastic increase?
