Various European media have recently reported on uncertainties about the incineration of meat-and-bone meal in Spain in 2003. According to official government figures, 400 000 tons of meat-and-bone meal was disposed of by means of incineration. According to the Spanish organisation representing operators of incinerators, however, the figure was only 40 000 tons.

- 1. Is the Commission aware of this issue?
- 2. Will the Commission call on Spain to explain the 360 000 ton discrepancy? If not, why not?
- 3. Will the Commission take measures to protect the health of European consumers and prevent this meat-and-bone meal from entering the food chain, in accordance with the current ban on feeding livestock with meat-and-bone meal? If so, what measures? If not, why not?
