Subject: Measures against price manipulation in the cereals sector

In October 2003, a case of large-scale manipulation of pricing in the cereals sector came to light, which led, inter alia, to the arrest of a Commission official.

- 1. Can the Commission outline the history of the investigation into this case and the present situation regarding it?
- 2. Did this manipulation of prices damage the financial interests of the EU, and if so, how seriously?
- 3. In view of this large-scale manipulation, should the way in which the management of markets in agricultural products is organised be reviewed?
- 4. What changes to this system and what measures relating to staff has the Commission so far carried out?
- 5. Will the Commission consult the Court of Auditors about possible improvements which could be made to the present system?
