In an answer to Anna Ibrisagic (H-0158/05<sup>1</sup>), the Commission states that, as a third country, Andorra is not obliged to observe the EU's 'acquis communautaire'.

Does the Commission mean by that statement that Andorra - as one of the EU's cooperating partners - is not obliged to observe generally applicable legal standards, or does it merely imply that the Commission wishes to take a passive approach to possible problems? Further to its answer, can the Commission say whether it is aware of any abuse of power by persons in authority in Andorra?
