Subject: Review of cod catch quotas for the purposes of the multiannual plan

In its proposal for a Council Regulation fixing the fishing opportunities and associated conditions for certain fish stocks and groups of fish stocks in the Baltic Sea (2007) of 5 September 2006, the Commission recommended a progressive reduction in cod catch quotas of 15% annually, together with an annual 10% reduction in the number of fishing days.

However, efforts to achieve the objective of the Commission's multiannual plan are being undermined by the failure of a number of Baltic countries to comply with current cod catch quotas, something not to be taken lightly.

- 1. Can the Commission confirm Polish newspaper reports (Gazeta Wyborcza of 3 August 2006) to the effect that, in 2004, Polish cod catches in the Baltic Sea of between 70 000 and 100 000 exceeded the quota many times over?
- 2. Is it possible consistently to enforce present and future Community rules and provisions on Baltic Sea cod catches in all Member States and monitor the implementation thereof?
