- 2. What additional measures are planned?
- 3. Is the Commission providing for an impact assessment?
- 4. What are the timing arrangements?
- 5. Is there a proposal to make it mandatory to fit wagons with K-type composite brake blocks?
- 6. Could a Member State come forward with a national assistance programme for retrofitting with K-type composite brake blocks, or would such a freight wagon retrofitting programme be in breach of European rules on aid?
- 7. Is the Commission aware of other, possibly less costly solutions for retrofitting freight wagons with a view to noise abatement?
