Subject: Anti-dumping measures against Chinese steel imports

Why is the Commission holding back from taking anti-dumping measures against steel imports from China, when it knows that these have risen by 60% since January 2007, and that prices have fallen by 15 to 25%?

Does the Commission not think that European steel producers are suffering from totally unfair competition, and that it should establish charges on Chinese steel imports as a matter of urgency?
