Subject: Communication about the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT)

In a globalised world, innovation is the only way in which Europe can preserve and increase its prosperity. At the request of Parliament, the European Institute of Technology (EIT) has been renamed the 'European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT)'. It is due to be launched this year.

However, the current logo of the EIT does not yet include the word 'Innovation', and therefore does not yet accord with the decision on the subject, which could cause confusion.

What will the Commission do to in order, in its communication about the EIT, to alter the EIT's logo to bring it into line with the institute's new official name?
