Subject: Threat to mixed-sex schools in France

The French Government is using the transposition of a European directive into French law as a pretext for plans to organise classes by grouping pupils according to sex.

Can the European Commission confirm that there is no directive which requires pupils to be taught on a single-sex basis or which might lead to such a requirement, and that the organisation of education is in fact the responsibility of the Member States?
