Subject: Detailed results of competition EPSO/AD/60/06 - Field 1

Significant disparities have been noted between Poland and other Member States as regards the filling of reserve lists following competition EPSO/AD/60/06 for AD5 administrator (human resources) posts:

Cyprus: 10 places on the reserve list / 13 successful candidates:

Czech Republic: 25 places on the reserve list / 25 successful candidates;

Estonia: 15 places on the reserve list / 15 successful candidates; Hungary: 20 places on the reserve list / 20 successful candidates; Lithuania: 15 places on the reserve list / 17 successful candidates; Latvia: 15 places on the reserve list / 15 successful candidates; Malta: 15 places on the reserve list / 15 successful candidates; Slovenia: 15 places on the reserve list / 16 successful candidates; Slovakia: 10 places on the reserve list / 19 successful candidates; Poland: 145 places on the reserve list / 83 successful candidates.

Given that the Polish candidates were examined by a different selection board from the candidates from the other Member States, would the Commission supply detailed marks for the candidates who took the tests, in order to enable a comparative analysis to be performed?

With a view to carrying out a thorough analysis, the marks for all candidates – both those who were called for an interview and those who were not – are required. We would ask for the following to be provided for each candidate:

- results of the written examinations;
- results of the interview;
- Member State of origin.

Would the Commission supply the candidates' marks without their personal details and any other information enabling individual candidates to be identified?
