Subject: Situation with regard to the infringement procedure opened with regard to the underground routing of the M-30

As part of the infringement procedure opened with regard to the underground routing of the M-30 (Madrid, Madrid Autonomous Community, Spain), and in the light of the court rulings on the construction work (and specifically, the ruling handed down by the Madrid Administrative Disputes Court [Juzgado de lo Contencioso-Administrativio] declaring the work to be illegal), will the Commission please provide specific answers as soon as possible to the following:

- 1. How far has Madrid City Council complied with the undertakings it gave the Commission with regard to carrying out the appropriate environmental impact assessment on the already-constructed sections of the underground routing in question, and likewise on the further sections planned, in accordance with Directive 85/337/EEC1?
- 2. Does the Commission believe that the environmental impact assessments carried out to date by Madrid City Council can replace the drawing-up of the environmental impact assessment required by the Directive?
- 3. What corrective and compensatory measures has Madrid City Council undertaken to implement, or is it currently implementing to reduce prejudice to humans and/or the environment as a result of the underground routing work in question, in the light of the environmental impact assessment (if it has been drawn up) or of the partial reports (if such exist)?
- 4. What checks has the Commission carried out to verify whether Madrid City Council has strictly complied with the undertakings it has given under the infringement procedure referred to above?
- 5. Has the European Investment Bank unblocked the loan requested by the Madrid City Council for the underground routing of the M-30 and suspended by the EIB on a proposal from the Commission, in the wake of the demonstrated failure of the City Council to comply with Community legislation?
- 6. Does the Commission believe that the City Council's so-called Proyecto Madrid-Río complies with the obligations laid down by current European law?
