Subject: Operation of stem-cell banks in the EU

While it is no secret that the operation of stem-cell banks is governed by the provisions of Directives 2004/23/EC<sup>1</sup>, 2006/17/EC<sup>2</sup> and 2006/85/EC<sup>3</sup>, disagreement continues to exist in many countries regarding the terms and conditions for the operation of private stem-cell banks.

Can the Commission provide the following information:

- 1. How many stem-cell banks are operating legally within the EU Member States? Does it have information for each Member State?
- 2. Has the basic Directive 2004/23/EC been transposed into national law by the Member States? If not, why not?
- 3. Have Commission inspectors been sent to the stem-cell banks in question and what were their findings?
