Subject: Funding of the A 14 motorway

The A 14 motorway is one of the most crucial projects in East Germany, particularly for the *Land* of Saxony-Anhalt. This project has come up for discussion again owing to a miscalculation and a resulting EUR 500 million shortfall in funding. In this connection I should like to ask the Commission the following questions:

- 1. Is the A 14 to be co-financed out of the TEN-T budget or from ERDF appropriations?
- 2. Did Germany supply evidence of the availability of full funding for the overall A 14 project?
- 3. Are there any potential additional sources of funding should the money be insufficient?
- 4. Has final approval been given for the EUR 327 million from European funds currently under discussion for the A 14?
- 5. Can a project, once approved, be redefined as several part projects?
- 6. Must the appropriations from co-financing be drawn down separately for every section, or can all the money from EU funds be utilised first in order to honour settlement deadlines?
- 7. Would it theoretically be possible to use the funding for a four-lane non-motorway main road (*Bundesstrasse*) instead?
