Subject: Victims of terrorism

What is the Commission doing with regard to the statistics on terrorist attacks and their victims?

Given that the terrorist threat is a reality and that a number of people have unfortunately been and will continue to become victims of past and future terrorist attacks, what action is the Commission taking on their behalf?

What is the Commission's stance on the valuable work of the European Network of Victims of Terrorism? What is the Commission doing to ensure that the Network is more involved in the development of policies to support victims in the Member States and to promote the European Charter for the Rights of the Victims of Terrorism?

Can the Commission specify what measures are being taken to promote victims' rights, both from a practical viewpoint and to defend the memory and dignity of the victims and seek justice for them?
