Subject: Multiculturalism as a way to dilute identities

I refer to the Commission's reply to questions E-4895/2010 and E-4896/2010.

The Commission is aware of falling birth rates amongst the indigenous populations of the EU Member States. It is similarly aware of the falling populations of those states.

It is also aware of the high birth rates in ethnic communities within those states, and of continued non-EU migration thereto.

1. Will the Commission now confirm that it acknowledges the inevitability of the indigenous populations ultimately being reduced to minority status, which will be the outcome unless the above trends are halted and reversed?
2. Why should the indigenous populations accept the influx of non-EU immigrants when they have not been consulted about it, let alone the consultation of future generations of indigenous people?
