Subject: Air passenger rights

The Commission will soon publish a Communication setting out its legislative agenda for air passenger rights.

As a consequence of the 'one bag rule', air passengers who purchase at retail outlets located airside are often forced to pay an additional charge to bring their purchases on board a flight.

Will the Commission recognise in the forthcoming Communication the right of passengers travelling by air to carry certain specified items on board a flight without a charge being imposed?

In this context, will the Commission consider retail items purchased airside as a 'specified item' which passengers may be permitted to bring on board a flight irrespective of the 'one bag rule' imposed by certain airline operators?
