Subject: Debate on the 2030 climate and energy package

Can the Commission confirm that the guiding basis for its proposal on the 2030 energy and climate policy framework will be constituted by the European Council position of March 2011<sup>1</sup>, the position of the recent Environment Council meeting of December 2012<sup>2</sup> and Parliament's resolution of 15 March 2012 on 'a Roadmap for moving to a competitive low carbon economy in 2050', which proposed an objective for the Union of reducing greenhouse gas emissions by 80-95 % by 2050 compared with 1990?

Does the Commission envisage that the 2030 framework will also include binding targets for renewable energy and energy efficiency, given that these are the 'no regrets' options set out in the energy roadmap for 2050?
