Does it have an opinion on whether the Irish Bank Resolution Corporation breached the terms of its Commitments Letter to the Commission by issuing a further EUR 5 million Ioan to Mr McKillen in 2012 to pay legal costs, when his debt with the IBRC amounted to approximately EUR 900 million in personal and corporate accounts at the time?
