Question for written answer E-001802/2015 to the Commission Rule 130 Jan Huitema (ALDE) and Bas Belder (ECR)

Subject: Progress of the assessment of new plant-breeding techniques

In its response to Jan Huitema's questions (E-006525/2014, 17.10.2014), the Commission stated that it intended to complete the legal analysis of new plant-breeding techniques such as cisgenesis within the forthcoming months.

- 1. How much progress has been made in the legal analysis of new plant-breeding techniques since the Commission responded to Jan Huitema's questions, and can the Commission now clarify when the legal analysis will be completed?
- 2. Is the Commission aware of EU citizens' positive attitude towards cisgenesis¹, and is it prepared to take these findings into consideration in its assessment of new plant-breeding techniques such as cisgenesis?
- 3. Can the Commission explain how products produced using new plant-breeding techniques such as cisgenesis will be labelled if the Commission decides that these techniques should no longer be considered as genetic modification?
