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Subject: Partial ban on neonicotinoids

The Commission is meant to review the current partial ban on neonicotinoids in 2015.

- 1. One year into the ban on neonicotinoids, what data from scientific papers and field trials have the Commission and the European Food Safety Authority (EFSA) collected?
- 2. On what basis are Member States granted derogations from this ban? Does the Commission properly assess the real necessity and the availability of alternatives, before derogations are accepted?
- 3. According to Regulation (EU) 1107/2009, pesticide derogations may be granted when no reasonable alternative exists. What is the Commission's definition of what is a 'reasonable alternative'?

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
