Subject: Monitoring and assessing Germany's failure to respect minority rights

We receive many reports of failure to respect the rights of the Polish minority in Germany in connection with education, culture, Polish-language schooling and many other areas of society. This is in breach of the provisions of the Charter of Fundamental Rights, which prohibit discrimination on the grounds of nationality.

Is the Commission monitoring such practices and assessing whether they are in breach of the Charter of Fundamental Rights, and does it have any comparative research on this issue from other Member States?

If it does, is the Commission able to set out best practices in this area of public policy?
