Subject: Anti-dumping duties

In view of the numerous messages I am receiving from Polish importers regarding the large number of procedures being brought for the retrospective imposition of anti-dumping duties and on the way in which these procedures are being conducted by national authorities, I should like to put a number of questions to the Commission.

Does the Commission have data on the number of procedures in which higher duties have been retrospectively imposed on entities importing goods from outside the EU based on the assumption that the goods in question originated in countries subject to anti-dumping policy?

Could the Commission indicate whether there are plans, given the concerns reported by importers, to draw the attention of Member States' customs authorities to the need to carry out procedures in a shorter time frame than before and in compliance with the assumption that the documents obtained by the importers from the national authorities of the exporting countries are, in principle, authentic?
