Subject: TAXE Special Committee: documents requested

The Special Committee on tax rulings (TAXE) set up to deal with the 'LuxLeaks' affair, has asked to inspect certain documents as part of its investigation. The request was made to the relevant Commissioner, Pierre Moscovici.

At the committee's meeting of 17 September 2015 the Commissioner stated that it was not possible to comply with the MEPs' request for information in its entirety. The Member States' consent was required to release these documents, and in the case of certain documents this had not been forthcoming.

1. Has the Commission attempted to obtain this information?
2. If so, what date appears on the requests to the Member States, when did they reply and which Member States refused their consent?
