Subject: ESF Languedoc-Roussillon - sedentary groups that were previously nomadic

The European Social Fund (ESF) is the main source of European funding in support of employment and social inclusion. One of the priorities of the ESF is to assist people belonging to disadvantaged groups by funding projects at local, regional and national level.
