Subject: Glyphosate

For some time now, we have been receiving information indicating that glyphosate – an ingredient in many plant protection products – could cause cancer. In 2002, the EU stated that glyphosate is not genotoxic, but recent studies are undermining this view by indicating that it may have a negative impact on human and animal health, leading to congenital defects, cancer and other serious illnesses. The International Agency for Research on Cancer (IARC) is investigating the issue of glyophosate.

- 1. Is the Commission familiar with the latest studies on glyphosate?
- 2. Is the Commission monitoring the conclusions of those studies?
- 3. What steps does the Commission intend to take vis-à-vis glyphosate?
