Subject: Approval and surveillance of two- or three-wheel motor vehicles

Regulation (EU) No 168/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 January 2013 on the approval and market surveillance of two- or three wheel vehicles and quadricycles entered into force on 1 January 2016. The objectives of the regulation are to ensure the safety of vehicle users and environmental performance.

It is important that it is implemented effectively and that the standards set out in it are complied with in order to ensure that consumers have full confidence and that their rights are respected.

1. Can the Commission confirm that the deadlines for implementation set out by the regulation have been respected by all Member States?
2. If not, which Member States are concerned and what does the Commission intend to do about it?
