Subject: Radicalisation Awareness Network

On 14 June 2016, the Commission brought forward a proposal for stronger EU action to tackle the radicalisation that is leading to violence and terrorism. Measures were outlined for the various areas in which cooperation at EU level can bring added value. One of these provides for promoting research and gathering evidence through various networks with the aim of developing specific instruments to prevent and combat radicalisation, based on in-depth analyses of the process. A key role in this respect is to be played by the Radicalisation Awareness Network.

Can the Commission state, in this connection:

1. Whether it is planning more concrete initiatives to improve cooperation between the Radicalisation Awareness Network and the Member State institutions responsible for policies to combat radicalisation and, if so, what these are?
2. Whether it intends to harness the experience of the Radicalisation Awareness Network to create a common European training module for experts in the prevention and combating of radicalisation?
