Subject: Blood alcohol level limits in the EU

A Swedish minister was recently forced to resign for drink driving with a blood alcohol level of 0.2 mg/ml. Her journey began entirely legally in Copenhagen, where the limit is 0.5 mg/ml. In crossing the Öresund Bridge, however, the Swedish limit of 0.2 mg/ml became applicable and her journey suddenly became illegal. As far as I can see, at least five different drink driving limits apply on EU borders at present. Has the Commission looked into this issue?
