Subject: Intcen report on the coup in Turkey: the consequences

According to a report in the British newspaper *The Times* on 17 January 2017, a confidential Intcen document reveals that Fethullah Gülen was not behind the attempted coup in Turkey on 15 July 2016. According to the report, 'the huge wave of arrests in the days following the coup attempt was already previously prepared. The coup was just a catalyst for the crackdown prepared in advance'.

Yet on 15 November 2016, Commissioner Frans Timmermans told the Flemish weekly *Knack* that a US report confirmed that the Fethullah Gülen movement had indeed played a role in the attempted coup.

What version of the facts does the Commission now support?

Can the Commission provide references for the US report referred to by Commissioner Timmermans?

Is the Commission prepared, in the interests of transparency, to disclose the Intcen report?
