Subject: Public intervention for milk

Some 350 000 tonnes of skimmed milk powder (SMP) were placed in public storage in 2015 and 2016. Following a proposal by the Commission, the Member States agreed to the first sales of SMP in public intervention in mid-December 2016. Only 40 tonnes were sold in December 2016 during the first tender, at a minimum sale price of EUR 215.10 per 100 kg. Bids were submitted by the United Kingdom and Germany for 20 tonnes each.

Can the Commission say:

- 1. Which dairies sold the SMP placed under public intervention in 2015 and 2016? What volume of SMP was sold by each of the dairies?
- 2. Which companies submitted bids to buy the SMP in public intervention during the three most recent tenders?
- 3. During the first tender, bids from Germany and the United Kingdom were accepted for the sale of 20 tonnes each. Who submitted these bids?
