Subject: Legal status of Syrian refugees in the Gulf States

The media has been discussing the issue of how the Gulf States are dealing with Syrian refugees for a long time now. One the one hand, it has been noted that countries such as Saudi Arabia and the UAE are making efforts to provide these refugees with assistance¹. On the other hand, there has also been criticism of the fact that Syrians have not been granted official refugee status, and as such have no rights².

- 1. Does the Commission know how many Syrian refugees have found refuge in the Gulf States?
- 2. Does the Commission have figures as to how many Syrians have emigrated from the Gulf States towards the EU?
- 3. What measures has the Commission taken so far to improve the legal situation of refugees in the Gulf States?
