Subject: Road safety in the EU Member States

On 28 March 2017 the Commission published a report on road safety which showed that road deaths fell by 2% in 2016 compared with 2015. The Commission maintains that road safety has improved across the EU, with the number of fatal accidents down by as much as 16% since 2010. Unfortunately, this positive trend does not apply to all Member States, including Poland.

In view of the above:

1. What resources is the Commission investing in the promotion of road safety?
2. What action does the Commission intend to take to promote road safety in the future, especially in countries where the number of accidents has not fallen?
3. Will the Commission conduct a more thorough assessment of the causes of the varying rates at which road safety is improving across the different Member States?
