Subject: Destruction of EU-subsidised schools in the West Bank

An article in the 'Independent'<sup>1</sup> of 24 August 2017 reported that Israel had destroyed buildings belonging to an EU-subsidised school in the West Bank.

1. Is this information about schools being destroyed by Israel correct? If so, how much money has the EU paid for the schools?
2. Had one or more of these schools which were destroyed already been destroyed once before? If so, when and by whom?
3. Is the reconstruction of the destroyed schools being supported by the Commission and, if so, what measures are planned?
