Subject: Cyber security

In the context of the work to transform ENISA into the planned EU Cyber Security Agency (the 'Cybersecurity Package') and the implementation of the NIS Directive, it is vital to enhance not only the institutional set-up but also the promotion of important cybersecurity projects. Cooperation between national Computer Security Incident Response Services (CSIRTs) and the planned certification of conformity with cybersecurity standards require promotion in order to ensure that the system which is developed to improve the response to security threats is used as widely as possible.

1. How has the Commission thus far promoted the activities of ENISA in the Member States?
2. How often have the Member States asked ENISA for support in creating a CSIRT, or assistance in cybersecurity training?
3. How does the Commission intend to promote the activities and usefulness of the future EU Cybersecurity Agency in light of the lessons learned from the activities of ENISA?
