Subject: Magnetic putty product

Could the Commission reassure parents that the magnetic putty product which was sold online to parents, causing children who played with it to have 10 times the normal level of arsenic in their bodies, has now been withdrawn from sale across the EU? Given that this illegal putty was sold online, have the producers been found and has legal action been taken against them? Could the Commission highlight what action it is currently taking to prevent illegal goods being sold to children in the EU?
