Subject: Integration of the Roma community

In 2011, the Commission adopted the EU Framework for National Roma Integration Strategies. They aim to bridge the gap between Roma and non-Roma communities in the following key areas: education, employment, housing conditions and health care. EU legislation, including the Racial Equality Directive and the Council Framework Decision on combating racism and xenophobia, prohibits anti-Roma discrimination, hate speech and xenophobic crimes.

Therefore, can the Commission say:

1. What legal, political and financial instruments have been activated or implemented in order to support and integrate the Roma community?
2. Has the situation of the Roma changed? In what areas has it changed?
3. What measures have been taken by Member States to integrate the still marginalised Roma community?
