Subject: Integration of the Roma community

In 2011, the Commission adopted the EU Framework for National Roma Integration Strategies. They aim to bridge the gap between Roma and non-Roma communities in the following key areas: education, employment, housing conditions and health care. EU legislation, including the Racial Equality Directive and the Council Framework Decision on combating racism and xenophobia, prohibits anti-Roma discrimination, hate speech and xenophobic crimes.

Therefore, can the Commission say:

- 1. What legal, political and financial instruments have been activated or implemented in order to support and integrate the Roma community?
- 2. Has the situation of the Roma changed? In what areas has it changed?
- 3. What measures have been taken by Member States to integrate the still marginalised Roma community?
