Subject: Post-Cotonou Agreement

The Cotonou Agreement strengthens relations between the EU and the ACP States in trade and development policies, promotes investments and places a focus on respect for human rights. The agreement was renegotiated and extended several times. This agreement will end on the expiry of the 2014-2020 multiannual financial framework, in which funds are designated for the Cotonou Agreement.

In their coalition agreement, the German parties CDU, CSU and SPD support both negotiations on a post-Cotonou agreement and also the creation of a Marshall Plan for Africa. In this regard, the African Union should be supported in implementing their Agenda 2063.
