Subject: Regulation (EU) 2015/1998

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/1998 allows for a passenger's liquids, aerosols and gels (LAGs) to be exempted from screening with liquid explosive detection systems equipment if they are in 'individual containers with a capacity not greater than 100 millilitres or equivalent in one transparent resealable plastic bag of a capacity not exceeding 1 litre, [...] and the bag is completely closed'.

Can the Commission state whether:

1. It has any plans to amend this regulation in any way, such as to allow passengers to take on board an aircraft two transparent resealable plastic bags containing LAGs?
2. It is monitoring the implementation of this regulation across EU airports? There are some airports in Europe which seem to adopt a more lenient approach to this, whereby passengers are allowed to place their LAGs into two or more clear plastic bags.
