Subject: The single digital gateway

Business growth and labour mobility within the EU single market depend on access to information about national regulations that is easy, universal and up-to-date. The recently proposed single digital gateway is a project designed to provide access to the national rules, requirements and procedures that citizens and businesses from other Member States need to know about and comply with to start their professional activities.
