Subject: Platform for coordinating cyber defence training activities

New challenges are emerging in Europe and worldwide, such as hybrid threats, which relate to cyber attacks or disinformation, therefore cooperation between Member States, the EU and other external partners is extremely important in order to strengthen the EU's capacity to respond to these challenges and to become more resilient in the face of chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear risks, with a view to providing effective protection to EU citizens.

The EU has proposed setting up a dedicated platform for training and educating the general public, in order to coordinate cyber defence training activities.

At what stage of implementation is this platform? Are different methods envisaged for this platform, based on a range of social groups? How can the platform be implemented to keep pace with potential new threats?
