Subject: Ecodesign and Energy Labelling Directive

The proposed regulation to implement Ecodesign Directive 2009/125/EC and the proposed delegated regulation on product energy labelling (pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2017/1369/EU) introduce new obligations in terms of labelling and registration for various types of lighting products, which, as a result, involve multiple industries, such as the marine and furniture sectors, which nowadays constantly use lighting elements in products placed on the market. To date, the impact assessment for this proposal has still not been published.

Therefore, can the Commission say:

- why this impact assessment has still not been published?
- whether, when preparing the proposal, estimations were carried out of the costs involved in these regulations for the various industries that use light sources as an integral part of their products?
