## Subject: Trade relations with Japan

Figures published by the Commission in 2012 revealed that only 28% of Japan's public procurement markets were potentially open to EU companies, whereas 85% of EU public procurement markets were open to Japanese companies. The Japan-EU Free Trade Agreement (JEFTA) is expected to increase marginally the degree of access EU companies enjoy to Japan's public procurement markets. However, I believe that reciprocity should be the foundation of our trade relations with Japan.

- 1. Can the Commission provide more information on how JEFTA may increase the degree of access EU companies enjoy to Japan's public procurement markets?
- 2. More generally, can it say how it is going to increase reciprocity in EU-Japan trade relations, particularly in the field of public procurement?
