Subject: Controls on dangerous lighters in the EU

Bic, a manufacturer of various consumer products, filed a complaint with the Commission against France and Germany in October 2018 for a lack of compliance controls for lighters imported into the EU. The company claims that a large number of imported lighters do not comply with European standards. According to Bic, lighters are responsible for 30 000 serious accidents per year in the EU, representing a cost to society of EUR 1 billion. BIC had already lodged a complaint against the Netherlands in 2010 and this procedure is still ongoing.

- 1. Can the Commission confirm the figures on serious accidents quoted by Bic?
- 2. When does the Commission think it will deliver its initial conclusions regarding the procedure against Germany and France?
- 3. At what stage is the procedure against the Netherlands and how can the time taken be explained?
