Subject: Very special advisers to the Commission in Brussels

In October 2017, Ms Joëlle Milquet, a Belgian citizen and former Deputy Prime Minister for the CDH (Humanist Democratic Centre – a Belgian party which welcomed the election of Emmanuel Macron)¹, was appointed Special Adviser to the President of the European Commission for the compensation of victims of crime, including victims of terrorism.

1. Given that her name appears in the Commission directory without an address or a telephone number, could the Commission make her contact details public so that I can contact her?
2. How many 'special' advisers are employed by the Commission without their contact details being included in the directory?
3. How much did the salaries paid to these 'special' advisers in 2018 amount to in total?
